Course Duration

Course is to be completed within 12 months part-time from commencement date

Delivery Mode

Prerequisites

- Completed Year 12 or equivalent (if student is under the age of 18 years at the commencement of this course they may be required to attend an interview to determine their suitability) **or**
- Student is 21 years or over at course commencement.

Course Fees
