DISTANCE AND IN-CLASS LEARNING

This fascinating study into small animal naturopathy explores areas such as anatomy and physiology, herbal medicine, herbal manufacturing, dog nutrition, pet food analysis, minerals, colloids, vitamins, acupuncture/meridians, massage, pathology, aromatic medicines, business practices, behavioural aspects, ethics, safety and efficacy. It must be pointed out that a veterinarian must always be consulted for a correct diagnosis. Once a correct diagnosis has been established then it is safe to proceed with the recommendations that the course will provide.

Course Duration

This course should take approx three years part-time based on approximately 10 hours per week (1330 hours total nominal hours). The in-class Canine Myofunctional Therapy Certificate course is included within this time estimation.

Delivery Mode

This course is offered by distance education (correspondence). The Canine Myofunctional Therapy Certificate course component is included in this course and is delivered through various options. (please see CMT individual courses)

Intake dates:

There are no intake dates for distance learning courses, you can commence at anytime during the year.

Prerequisites

There are no prerequisites for this course.

Course Fees
