Prerequisites

Qualifications and experience in an appropriate field of a human services profession, eg. Counselling, healthcare, communication, psychology, education, human resources, or law is recommended but not mandatory.

Course Fees

The upfront investment for this course is \$7,000.00

Payment Plan

An instalment plan is also available. Students who choose to pay by instalments go onto a payment plan which incurs a one off administration fee making the course \$7,900.00.
