DISTANCE LEARNING

Nutrition is the study of the treatment of disorders and diseases with specific substances, such as supplements, to correct or prevent an imbalance in the body. Further, it is the study of correction of one's daily diet to enable biomechanical balance to be achieved and maintained.

Course Duration

Recommended timeframe for the completion is approx 3 ½ years (part-time) or 2 years (full-time). Students have a maximum of 5 years to complete this course.

Delivery Mode

Distance education (correspondence).

Intake dates:

There are no intake dates for distance learning courses, you can commence at anytime during the year.

Prerequisites

- Completed Year 12 or equivalent (if student is under the age of 18 years at the commencement of this course they may be required to attend an interview to determine their suitability) **or**
- Student is 21 years or over at course commencement.

Course Fees

The upfront investment for this course is \$9,000.00

Payment Plan

An instalment plan is also available. Students who choose to pay by instalments go onto a payment plan which incurs a one off administration fee making the course \$10,170.00.

The breakdown is as follows:

\$8,970.00 is then divided into **24** equal monthly payments of **\$373.75** which is direct debited from your nominated savings or credit account.
