

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How do I become an agent for the National College of Traditional Medicine?

It is very easy. Simply apply to become an agent and fill out the appropriate form. Your application will be assessed by the appointed personnel and you will be notified within 14 working days from receipt of the application if your application has been successful

2. Why would my application not be accepted?

If you have had any problems with honesty or business integrity we would not accept the application as it may effect the reputation of the National College of Traditional Medicine.

3. How much does it cost me to apply?

Absolutely nothing!

4. How does it work?

Upon acceptance as an agent, we provide you with a promotion kit and you select the material you want in your pack. You may be interested in promoting only animal courses, or alternatively you may wish to promote the entire suite of courses offered by the National College of Traditional Medicine. You would then place your identification labels on each enrolment form that will be provided in your agent's kit.

5. Do I have to collect any enrolment money?

No. All the administration and payment processing is conducted through the National College of Traditional Medicine.

6. How do I get paid?

This is a very important question as it is necessary you find being an agent for the National College of Traditional Medicine is not only an enjoyable experience it is also one that will provide additional income.

For every enrolment form with your identification label on it: Certificate or Diploma level will earn you \$100.00.
